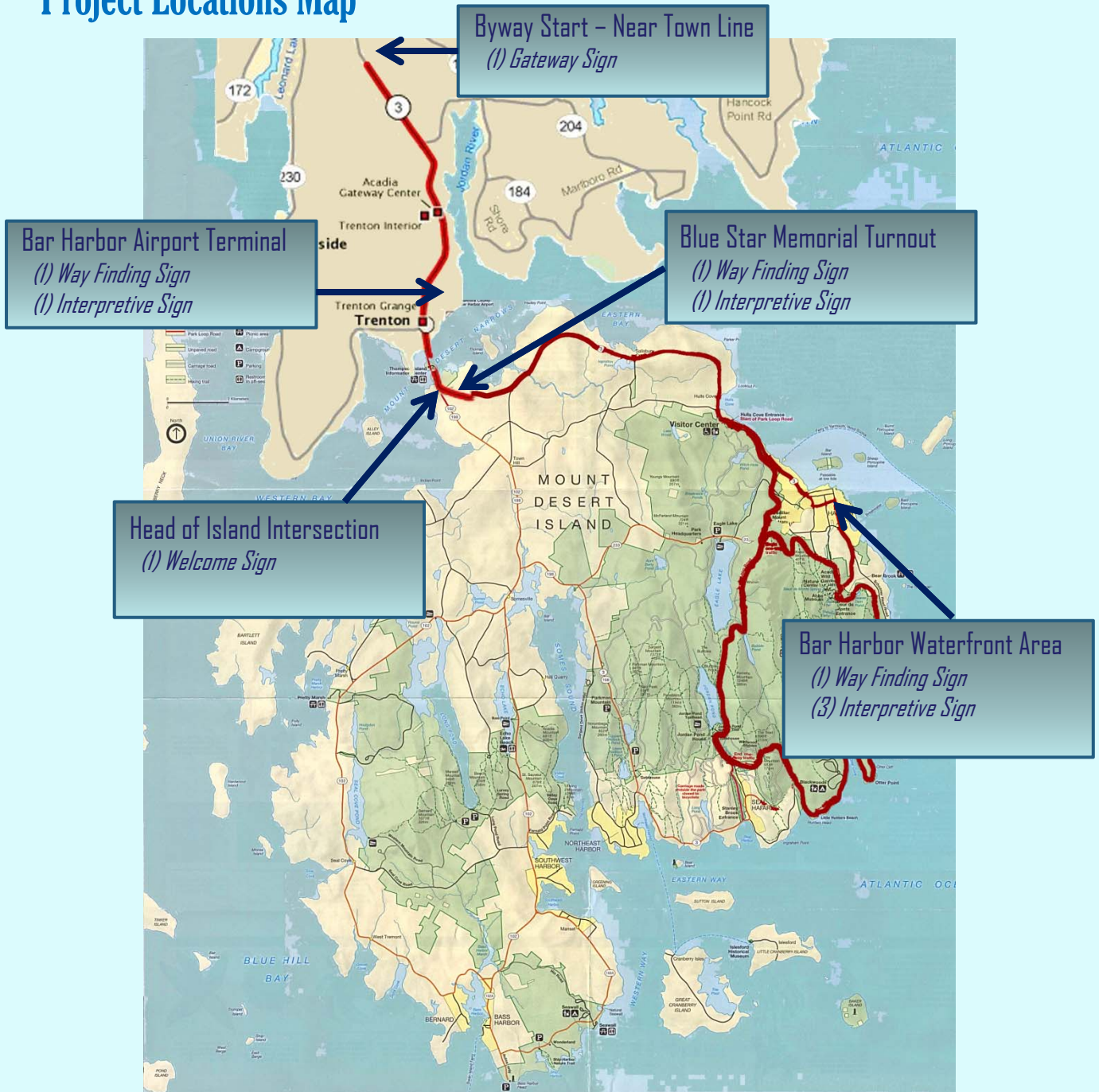

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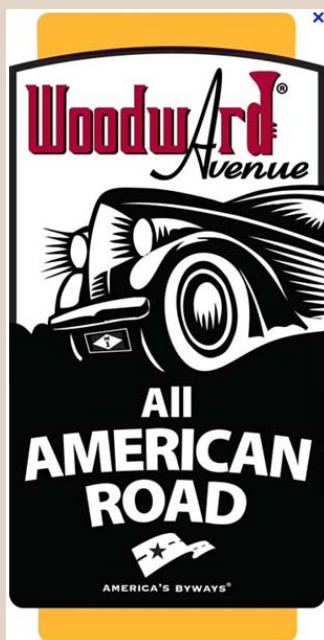
Acadia All American Road

 Acadia Byway “Gateway” Sign
 MaineDOT WIN 18197.00



Work scope:

- Gateway Sign – State Highway Road Sign
- Located in Right of Way
- No utility impacts anticipated
- Approx. 5' x4' on wooden breakaway posts
- MaineDOT Sign Shop Manufactures
- MaineDOT Sign Crew Installs
- Highly Contrasting and Visible Sign
- Ties into byway logo sign system
- Low Maintenance
- Coordinate location w/Region 4 Traffic Engineer
- Coordinate with adjacent landowner on placement
- No-Site work needed -just clean-up



(Option 2)
Acadia Byway “Gateway” Signage
MaineDOT WIN 18197.00



Work scope:

- Add sign to Existing Town Welcome Sign
- Located in Right of Way same location
- No utility impacts anticipated
- Match existing sign size and colors
- Mounts by L-brackets on post
- Decrease number of roadside signs
- Agreement with Town to own and maintain
- Coordinate w/Region 4 Traffic Engineer
- No-Site work needed -just clean-up

(Option 3) Acadia Byway “Gateway” Signage MaineDOT WIN 18197.00

Work scope:

- New gateway sign located in right of way and outside clear zone
- Not a great area for this type of sign
- No utility impacts anticipated
- Small size – low granite or stone veneer base
- Excavate 48" for footing
- Concern with this type of sign about people trying to stop for pictures.
- Low Maintenance design a must
- Coordinate location w/Region 4 Traffic Engineer
- Coordinate with adjacent landowner on placement
- Minor site work needed.
- MaineDOT owns and maintains – Not Ideal

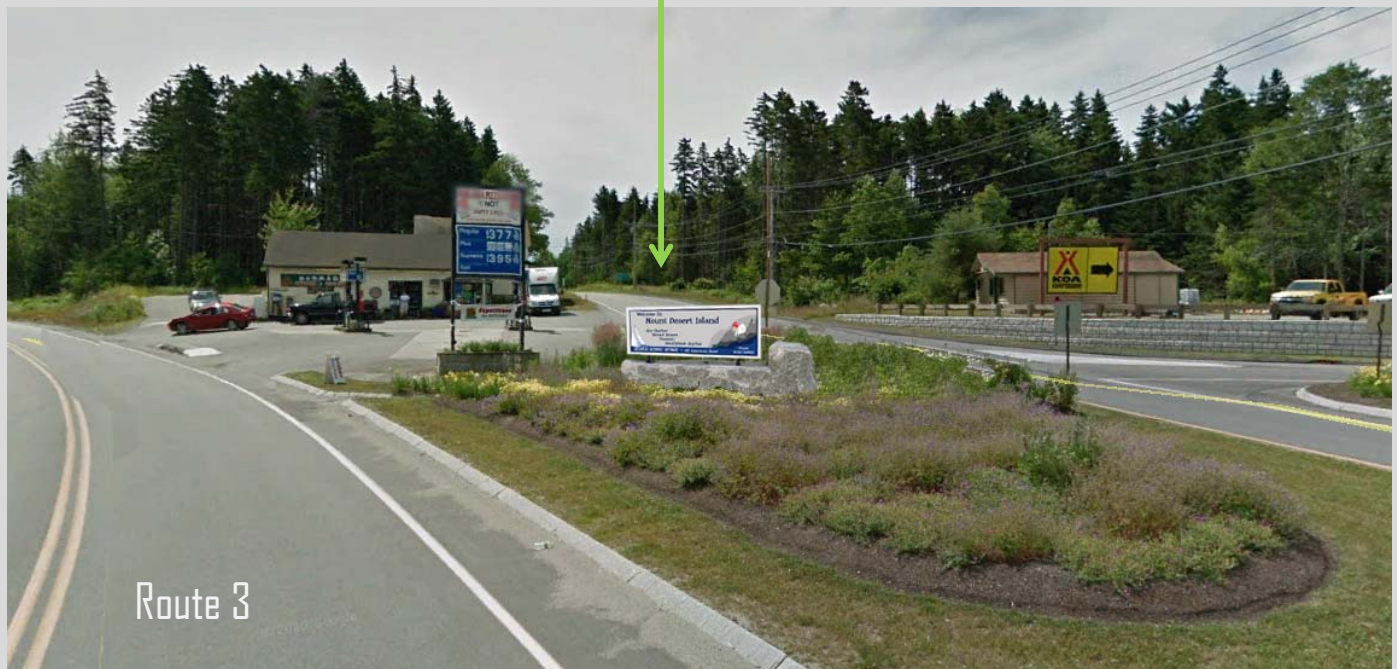
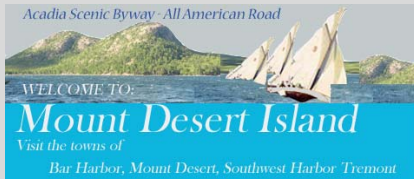


Work scope:

- Excavate 48" for footing
- Work with Town on graphic design
- Coordinate location w/Region 4 Traffic Engineer
- Coordinate with adjacent property
- Mesh with existing plantings and drainage
- Minor site work needed transplanting
- Work permit access from landowner
- Traffic control special provision needed
- Agreement with Town of Bar Harbor to own and maintain

Wayfinding Signs: (5) Themed panels with maps to promote byway activities and industries.

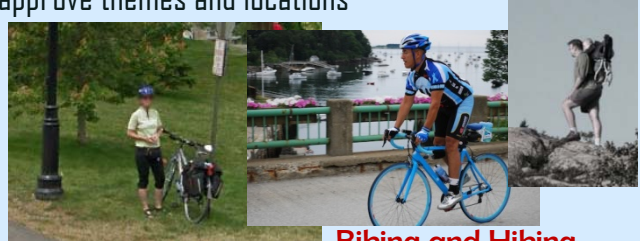

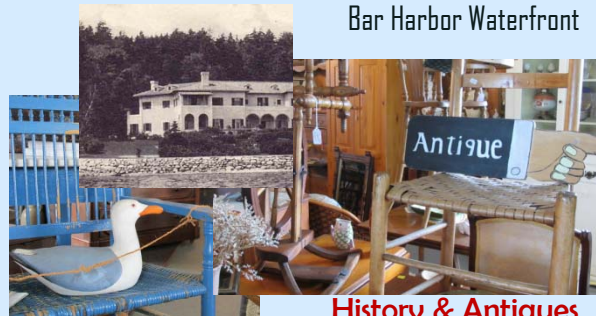

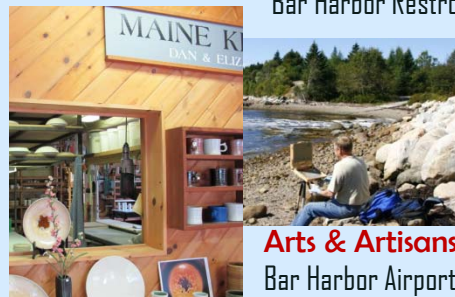

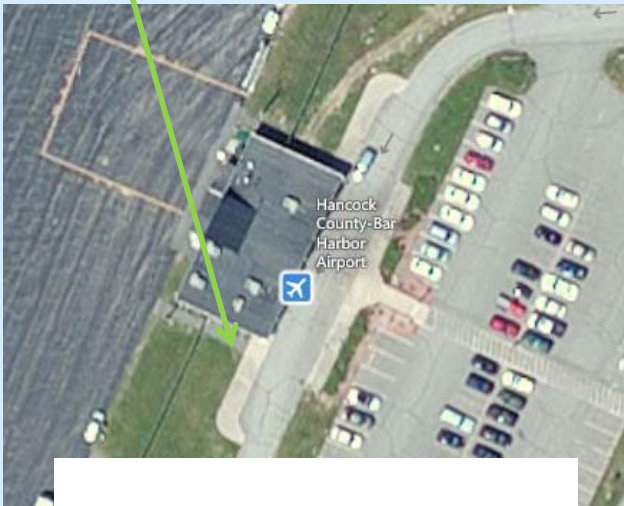

Bar Harbor Airport New Terminal

MaineDOT WIN 10917.60



Work scope:

- Sign located on airport property adjacent to proposed sitting area of new terminal
- Can be placed before or after new terminal is built and relocated to final spot as required
- No utility impacts anticipated
- 6" Excavation to set granite base
- Work with Airport Manager on all aspects of project
- Work permit access from landowner
- Agreement with Airport Authority to own and maintain

Work scope:

- New wayfinding sign located at existing Acadia Gateway Center Bus Stop
- No utility impacts anticipated
- Excavate 36-42" for granite posts
- Work with Gateway Center Group on design
- Mesh with existing plantings and bus stop functions
- Minor site work needed for transplanting
- Work permit access from landowner
- Traffic / Pedestrian control coordination needed
- Agreement with Gateway Center to own and maintain

- Agreement with Town of Bar Harbor to own and maintain

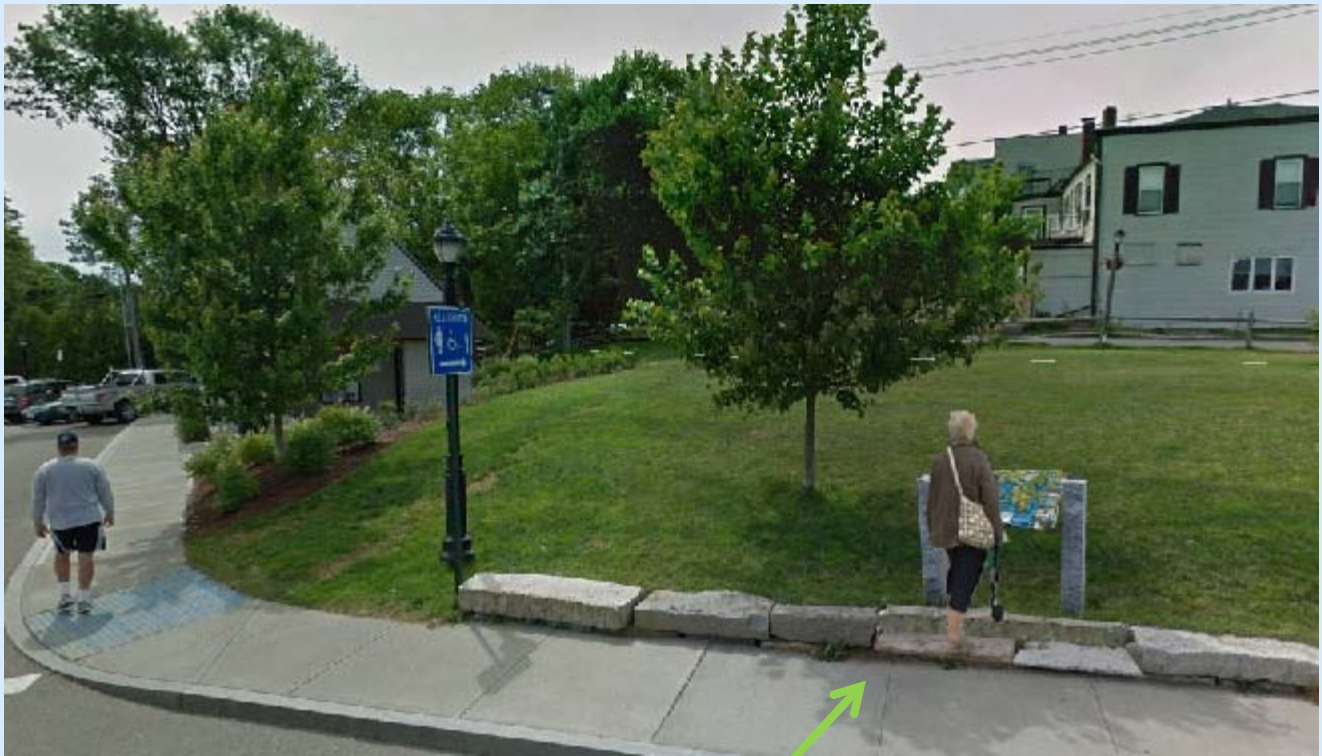

- Coordinate with adjacent property owners and businesses
- Minor site work needed relocate newspaper box
- Work permit access from town
- Traffic control special provision needed and notes about public safety
- Agreement with Town of Bar Harbor to own and maintain

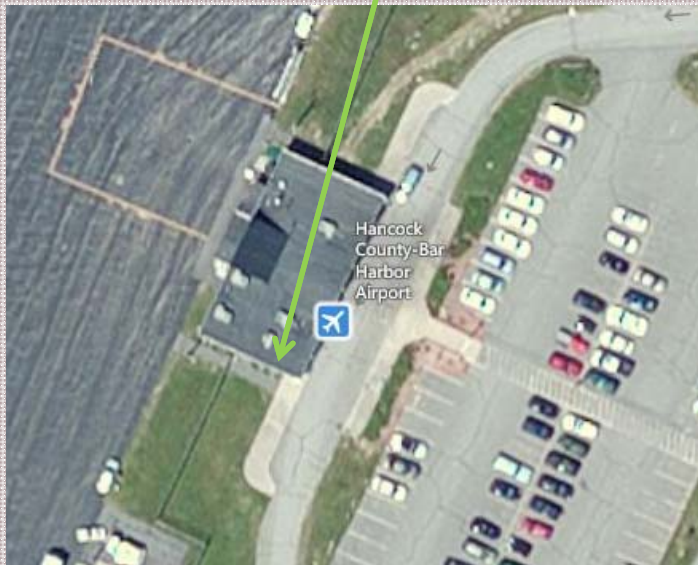

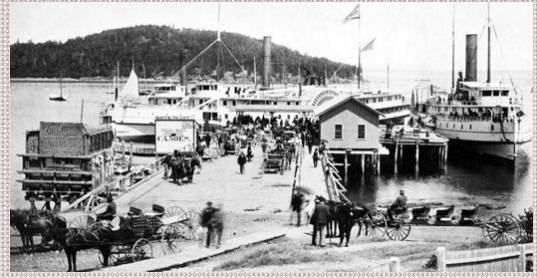
